LEQVIO® is used in adults to further lower your LDL ("bad" cholesterol) levels. It is for patients who are currently taking a statin (a medicine used to treat high cholesterol), sometimes in combination with another cholesterol-lowering medicine.

 $\mathsf{LEQVIO}^{\scriptscriptstyle \oplus}$ is used in addition to lifestyle changes, including diet in patients who have:

- Heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia (HeFH) (an inherited genetic disorder that causes extremely high cholesterol levels), or
- Non-familial hypercholesterolemia (a condition that affects the way your body processes cholesterol) with atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (a hardening of the arteries)

The effect of LEQVIO® on heart problems such as heart attacks, stroke, or death is not known.

Injection location and LEQVIO® delivery

Your Clinical Coordinator will help find an injection location that's appropriate for you, and handle the scheduling and delivery for every injection.



Injection reminders

Your Clinical Coordinator can provide reminders of upcoming injection appointments.



Follow-up calls

You'll get periodic calls from your Clinical Coordinator to follow up with you and provide tips for keeping track of your treatment.

Customizable injection location

With the help of your Clinical Coordinator, injection appointments can be set up at a location that is suitable for you. Here's how it works.



Step 1: Your Clinical Coordinator calls you to set up an injection appointment.



Step 2: Your Clinical Coordinator provides a list of options. Locations can include pharmacies near you as well as specialized clinics. If you want to receive your injection at home, your Clinical Coordinator can arrange that as well.



Step 3: Choose the option that's suitable for you.




Step 4: Your Clinical Coordinator arranges your injection. They will set up an appointment for your injection and ensure LEQVIO® is delivered to your location of choice.

LEQVIO® is always administered subcutaneously by a healthcare professional.

Your treatment schedule

The initial and second injections are given 3 months apart; subsequent doses are given every six months.



Your Clinical Coordinator keeps track of the following for you:

- ✓ They schedule injection appointments and coordinate LEQVIO® delivery every time.
- They will proactively call to remind you of injection appointments and provide medication tips.
- They can also remind you about the importance of any lab testing your physician recommends during treatment.
